  - ⌘ Pictures may be on paper size (8 ½ x 11) up to standard poster size (24 x 36) **HORIZONTAL**
  - ⌘ Picture should represent the slogan: **Every Child Deserves A Great Childhood**
  - ⌘ Entries may be completed by an individual child or a group of children (only one prize will be awarded regardless of size of group creating the artwork)
  - ⌘ All submissions must have completed Consent Form signed by parent/legal guardian (attached)
  - ⌘ **Entries should be submitted or delivered in person by March 13, 2020, at 4:00 p.m.** to Family Nurturing Center, 5 Spiral Drive, Florence, KY 41042.

## PRIZE:

The winning entry will receive:

- ⌘ Pizza party for school classroom, church group, or youth organization.


